

WHAT ARE THE PROCEDURES FOR ACCEPTANCE?

1. Each applicant must complete an application form.
2. Application form must be accompanied by at least two letters or recommendation.
 - a. Pastor of Trinity A. M. E. Zion Church
 - b. Dean of Hood Theological Seminary or a Professor at the Seminary
 - c. A member of the Daughters of Conference
 - d. Pastor from any other church in the A. M. E. Zion Connection
3. Must be approved first by the AAMP Committee. Secondly, the overall approval must come from the entire group of the Daughters of Conference.

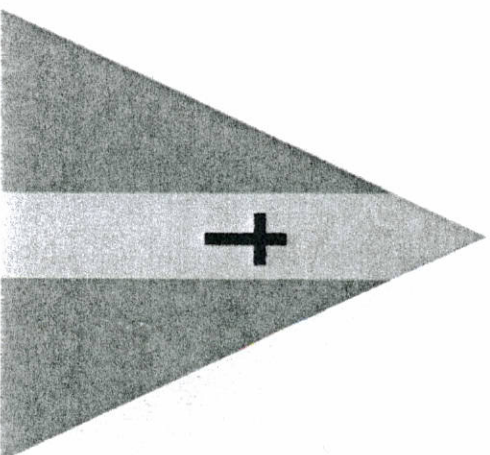
CAN A PERSON BE AN ADOPTEE FOR MORE THAN ONE ACADEMIC YEAR?

The legacy of the Daughters of Conference is full of self-sacrifice and devotion to the cause of missions and the promulgation of the Gospel.

Historians have written that these noble and dedicated women were organized in 1821. It is recorded that "The preacher must go and preach: Zion churches must be erected and we will give the money - and for this grand and glorious purpose the United Daughters of Conference were organized at that early, needy time in Mother Zion Church."

This organization was the greatest means of supporting preachers in establishing churches, education, and other needs of the church.

With this rich and noble heritage, the Daughters of Conference of Trinity A. M. E. Zion Church have established a scholarship fund for students attending **Hood Theological Seminary** in Salisbury, North Carolina. This financial assistance is called

(ADOPT-A-MINISTER PROJECT).

DEFINITIONS OF TERMS

USED

AAMP - Adopt-A-Minister Project

AAMP COMMITTEE - A five member committee made up of five Daughters of Conference who will have the responsibility of reviewing applications and making recommendations to the entire Daughters of Conference group at Trinity A. M. E. Zion Church.

ADOPTEE - Male or female adopted by the Daughters of Conference to receive financial aid for their theological training at **Hood Theological Seminary**.

HOW DOES A PERSON GO ABOUT BECOMING AN ADOPTEE?

- Express a desire for consideration either verbally or in written form.
- May be recommended to the AAMP Committee by any member of the Daughters of Conference or by the Pastor of the Church.

WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR EACH ADOPTEE?

1. Any male or female who has accepted the call for ministerial service - no age restrictions.

2. A person of good moral and ethical standing in the A. M. E. Zion Church.

3. A person who is enrolled or plans to enroll in **Hood Theological Seminary** to become a minister.

4. An individual committed to Zion Methodism.

WHO WILL BE CONSIDERED AS AN ADOPTEE?

Members of Trinity A. M. E. Zion Church will be considered first! If there is no one available at Trinity, then the entire Greensboro District will be considered. If no availability there, then the West Central North Carolina Conference will be considered.

WHAT EACH ADOPTEE WILL RECEIVE

Each ADOPTEE will receive adoption papers which will specify the amount of money to be given for the academic year that he/she is adopted by the Daughters of Conference.
